FAQ How does CSA Certification compare to UL Listing?

As a testing agency, CSA is fully accredited by OSHA, so the CSA Certification is equally valid.

CSA (C US) Certification is equivalent to UL Listing because the certification is to US Standards. The CSA (C US) nomenclature is the current version of what was previously called CSA NRTL (Nationally Recognized Testing Laboratory). The NRTL designation is equally valid, and appears as the mark on some products which were certified previous to the nomenclature change.

The CSA(C US) designation means “to Canadian and US Standards”.

The CSA(C) mark means “to Canadian Standards”.

The CSA(US) mark means “to US Standards”.
